Q: What is the Tax Loop Program?

A: .The Longtime Owner Occupants Program benefits lower-income homeowners who have been in their homes for at least 10 years and saw their property assessments increase by 300 percent or more this in 2014.

Q: What is the Homestead Exemption?

A: The Homestead Exemption offers real estate tax savings to Philadelphian’s homeowners by reducing the taxable portion of their property assessment by \$30,000.
